# TRANSPORT TRAFFIC SAFETY ROADS 2024

## ABOUT

We now understand that:

When we introduce movement into our daily lives, we increase the risk of harm to ourselves and others. We must always remember that our safety depends on the actions of others and their safety depends on our behaviours. We therefore have a shared responsibility to keep one another safe. As such we owe a duty of care to ourselves and others.

**TRANSPORT** is the safe movement of goods, services and passengers from one place to another. It links production, distribution, exchange and all other related activities.

**TRAFFIC** is the safe movement of people and vehicles, in a road sense referred to any form of motorised or non-motorised vehicle or person moving to reach a specific destination along with designing vehicles which will both react in a positive way when colliding with another person or object.

**SAFETY** the freedom to move about without fear of harm or unacceptable risks directly caused by hazards or the actions of others whilst recognising that road users make mistakes and training road users in an appropriate and proper manner.

**ROADS** providing a safe thoroughfare for the movement of traffic and connects one place to another or networks within towns and communities used by vehicles (motorised and non-motorised) and pedestrians and being designed and maintained in a way in which its features are forgiving in the event of a crash.

## WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This one day event of a conference style nature is for any person who is involved in the practice and promotion of road safety in terms of casualty reduction, reducing the risk to road users and making the environment smarter with active travel, reduction in CO2 emissions and innovation in mind.
